GETTING INVOLVED IN THE LIFE OF THE PARISH

There are many ways in which you can contribute to the vibrant life of our parish community. Consider giving of your time and talent by volunteering! Opportunities include:

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

The RCIA Program is for adults who wish to become full members of the Catholic Church. These could either be:

- adults who have never been Baptized;
- individuals Baptized in another Christian denomination who now wish to be Catholic;
- adult Catholics who have yet to be Confirmed or receive the Eucharist for the first time

The RCIA Program runs from Fall 2026 to Spring 2027, with the celebration of the Sacraments happening on Holy Saturday Night (27 March 2027). Exact meeting dates are still to be determined.

Individuals who are interested in joining the RCIA Program are asked to contact the parish office, or speak to one of our priests after Mass on Sunday. We also encourage all RCIA Candidates to begin the practice of regularly participating at Sunday Mass.
