- adult Catholics who have yet to be Confirmed or receive the Eucharist for the first time

The RCIA Program runs from Fall 2026 to Spring 2027, with the celebration of the Sacraments happening on Holy Saturday

Night (27 March 2027). Exact meeting dates are still to be determined.




