RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

The RCIA Program is for adults who wish to become full members of the Catholic Church. These could either be:

- adults who have never been Baptized;
- individuals Baptized in another Christian denomination who now wish to be Catholic;
- adult Catholics who have yet to be Confirmed or receive the Eucharist for the first time

Sessions for the RCIA Program are anticipated to begin in October and will run through Spring 2027, with the celebration of the Sacraments happening on Holy Saturday Night (27 March 2027). Exact meeting dates are still being finalized.

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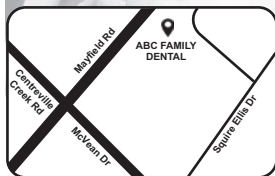
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
