<u>Annual Parish Financial Report for 2023</u>

Dear Parishioners of St Patrick's Parish,

I pray this finds each of you and your loved ones well, as on behalf of the members of the Parish Finance Council. I present our **Annual Parish Financial Report** for 2023. I do so with deep appreciation for all of your financial, material and spiritual support for St Patrick's Parish. Though the Report is not issued in as timely a manner as I would like, you can be sure of my commitment to openness, accountability and responsibility for the resources of this parish is as constant and strong as you deserve. All of us are called to be stewards of the gifts God has given us. In a particular way, I as your pastor have a special obligation to prudently and wisely manage the resources of the parish. This Report is one way of expressing my belief that this is being done well.

Among the positive items in the 2023 ledger, note that *total receipts for the year were up from a year prior by over 53%* (\$843,847.56 [2022] vs \$1,294,128.47 [2023]), while expenditures increased by only 34% (\$814,445.92 [2022] vs \$1,091,199.45 [2023]). The bulk of the increased income owes largely to the payment received for land sold in 2020 (on the south side of Mayfield Road, for the eventual widening of Mayfield Road; 221,781.09\$), and to increased revenue from the very successful 'Loaves and Fishes Gala 2023' (S420,279 (2023) vs S307,940 [2022]). Increased expenditures owe to more money put on deposit with the Archdiocese (see "New Investments Purchased": \$490,543.46 [2023] vs \$407,843.94 [2022]), and a significant increase in architectural and consultants' fees as our new parish building project advances.

On that front, we have submitted our Site Plan Proposal and are moving forward to get started. We hope to break ground no later than early 2026, if not sooner! In 2023, we raised \$436,128.63 toward the new church (\$623,766.54 income vs \$187,637.91 expenses). For a second year in a row, we did not have to dip into our reserves held on account with the Archdiocese. The Sunday and Feast Day collections were up marginally, which represents more people coming to Mass (I hope!), and/or greater generosity from those who come, for which I thank you from the bottom of my heart.

I wish to express my gratitude to the dedicated members of St Patrick's Finance Council for their continued work, diligence and service. They are invaluable to me in administering wisely, prudently and effectively the financial and temporal goods of the parish. Thank you also to the many, many volunteers who make this parish run: our office Staff and volunteers, lectors, extraordinary Ministers of Communion, our musicians, ushers ... to the many people whose love for God is so visible in your commitment to the people of this parish: **THANK YOU and God bless you!**

As we bid farewell to Fr Abraham and welcome Fr Fraser McLaren, know that I am grateful beyond words for all your support for the parish. Fr Fraser and I pledge to do everything we can — as a parish, as clergy, as a family — to support each other and to grow and love and serve. Should you have any questions, if there are any concerns or ideas that you wish to share, if you are looking for ways to serve the community, or if there is anything that you would like us to do for you, please do not hesitate to let us know.

Let us pray for one another, that we may be joyful, compelling, compassionate, and consistent witnesses to the truth of the Gospel and the love and mercy of God. In this way, our community's future will be strong and effective.
