WHO ARE WE?

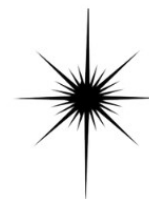

Advent is the special time before Christmas when we get our hearts ready for Jesus. It lasts four weeks, and it's all about waiting, hoping, and preparing — kind of like counting down to a big celebration.

During Advent, the Church uses the Advent wreath and candles to help us remember that Jesus is the Light coming into the world. Each candle reminds us of something important: hope, peace, joy, and love.


By praying, helping others, and paying attention to what really matters, we get ready to celebrate Jesus' birth at Christmas — the moment the world had been waiting for.
