

Early Catholic Family Life

The Office of Formation for Discipleship is piloting a new program called Early Catholic Family Life (ECFL) in parishes in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

How it began

In our office's consultations with parishes, one common gap that was identified was support for families with young children (ages of 0–6 years), the time typically between Baptism and First Communion. In particular, they identified a need to help parents lay the foundations for raising their children in the faith. We did our research and found an established program from the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis that meets this need called Early Catholic Family Life.

What is the ECFL Program?

- ECFL is a parent-child program aimed at an underserved but essential part of all parishes – parents with children 0-6 years old.
- ECFL is an 8-session 2-hour class.
 Classes can be offered weekly, monthly, on week days, weekends or during evening hours. Each class includes early childhood, faithbased and fun activities for families.
- ECFL consists of a parent-child interaction component, a parent discussion time and a children's time.
- ECFL gives parents an opportunity to learn more about their Catholic faith, discuss faith with other adults, and build supportive relationships within the parish.

Benefits to parishes:

- Training and support of parish leaders to provide a new program that helps young parents:
- Receive hands-on guidance in bringing the Catholic faith to their children
- Learn about their vocation, develop a vision for their family, are inspired to continue to grow in their own faith
- Build relationships with other parents, forming a Catholic community of parents for ongoing support and encouragement
- Deepen their relationship with the parish
- Consider Catholic education for their children.
